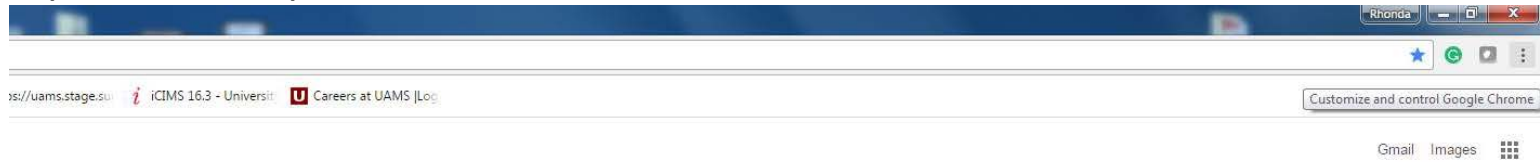
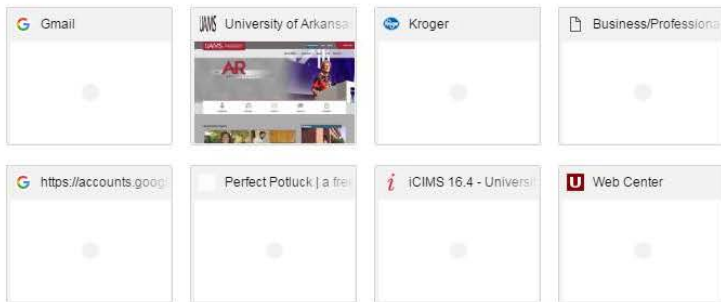


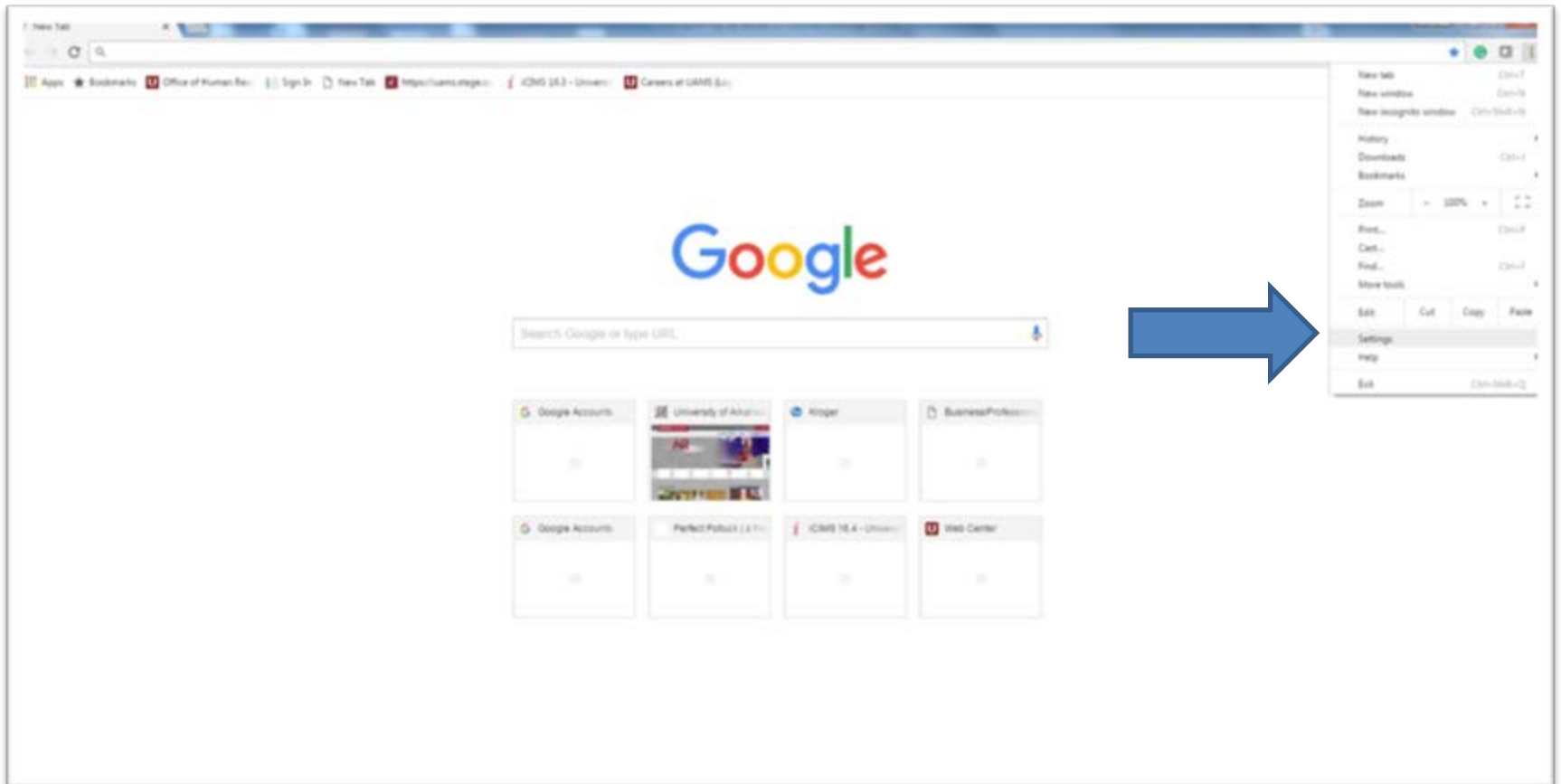
Step 1: Click on the ellipses next to shown here next to the URL field




Search Google or type URL

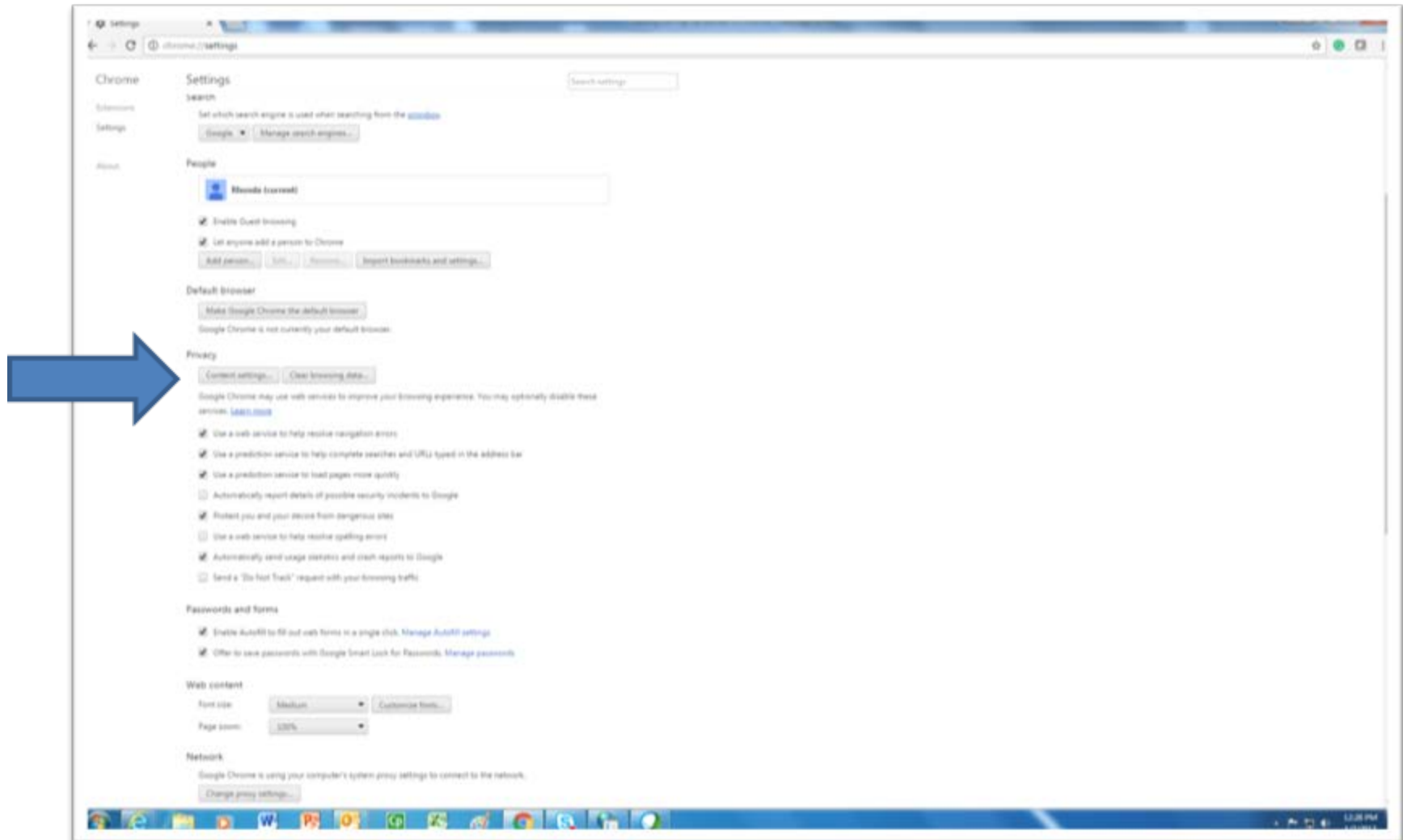
