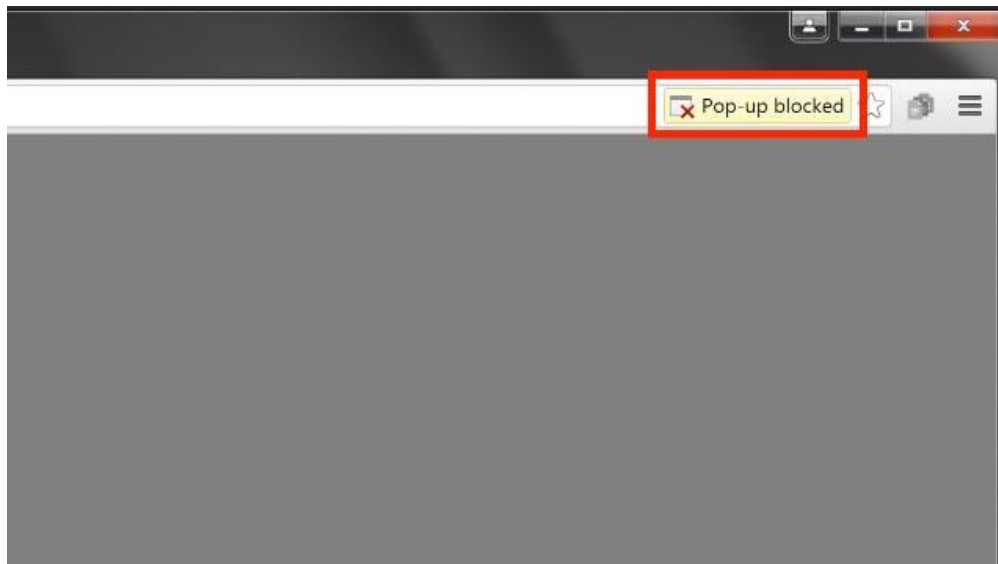

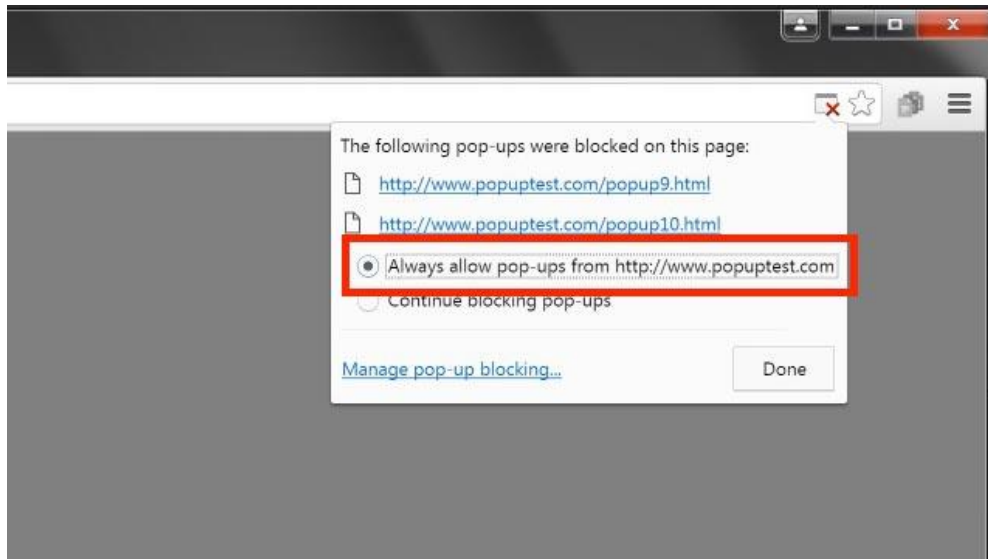
### Chrome for PC Disable a Pop-Up Blocker on a Web Page

Clicking the icon will allow you to:

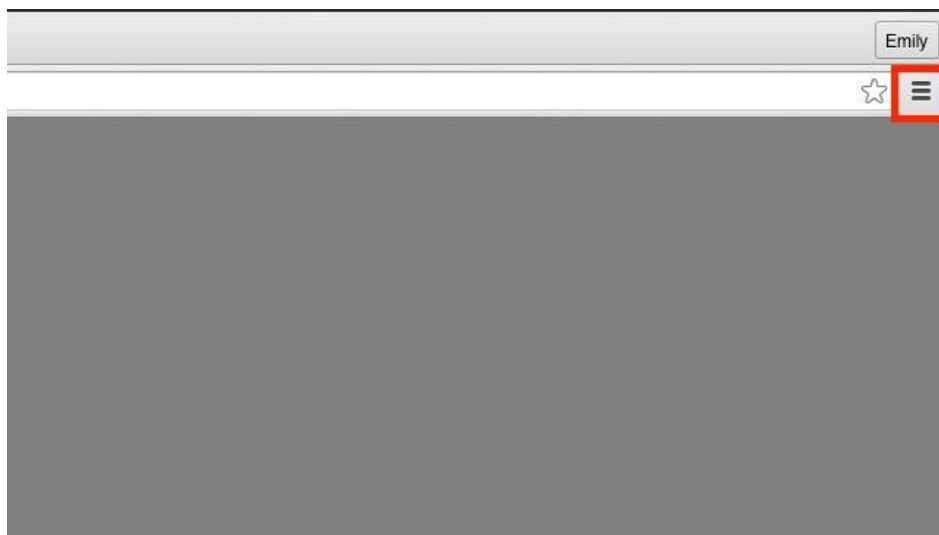
- Always allow pop-ups from this site

- Manage pop-up blocking



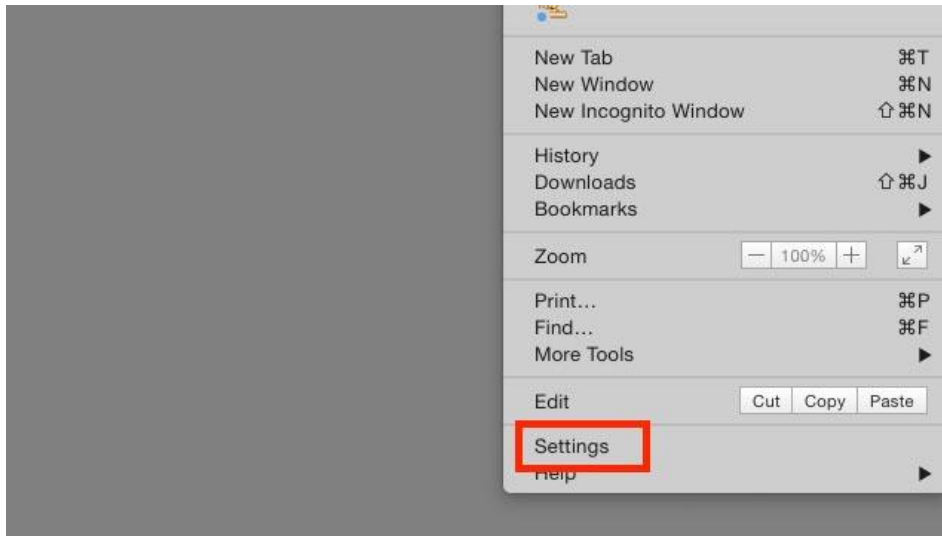

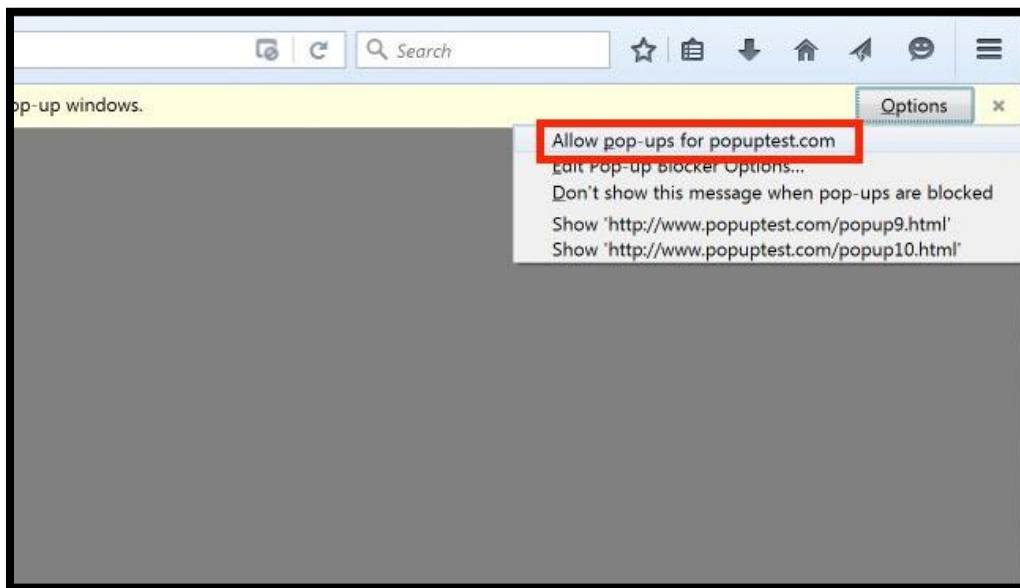
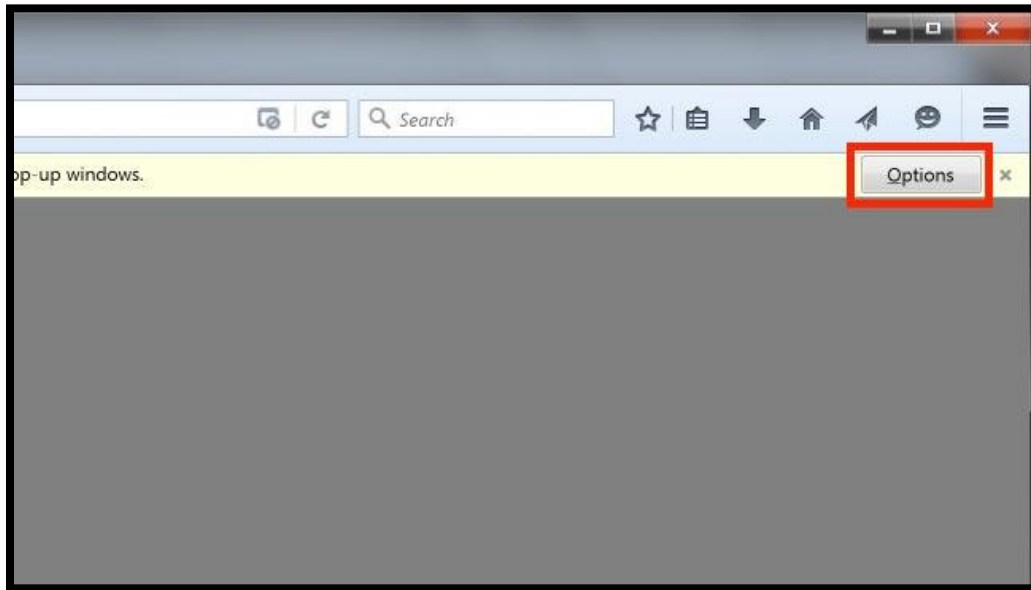
## How to Disable a Pop-Up Blocker: Firefox for PC

If a Web page tries to send you a pop-up when your blocker is turned on, an information bar will appear at the top of your browser window.

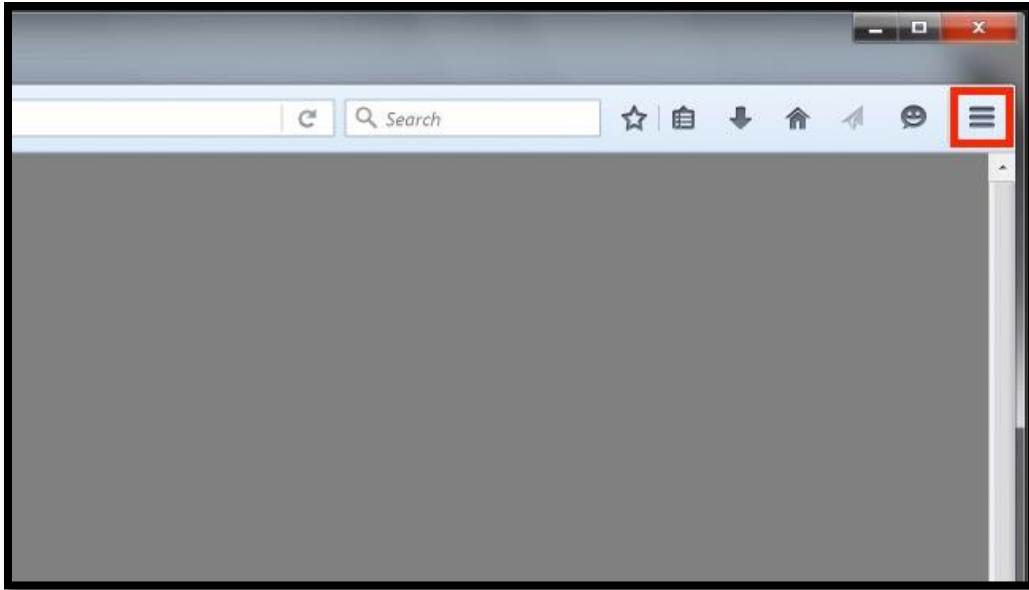
Clicking the **Options** button within the information bar will allow you to:

- Allow pop-ups from this site
- Edit your pop-up blocker options
- Never show an information bar when pop-ups are blocked
- Display the blocked pop-up window

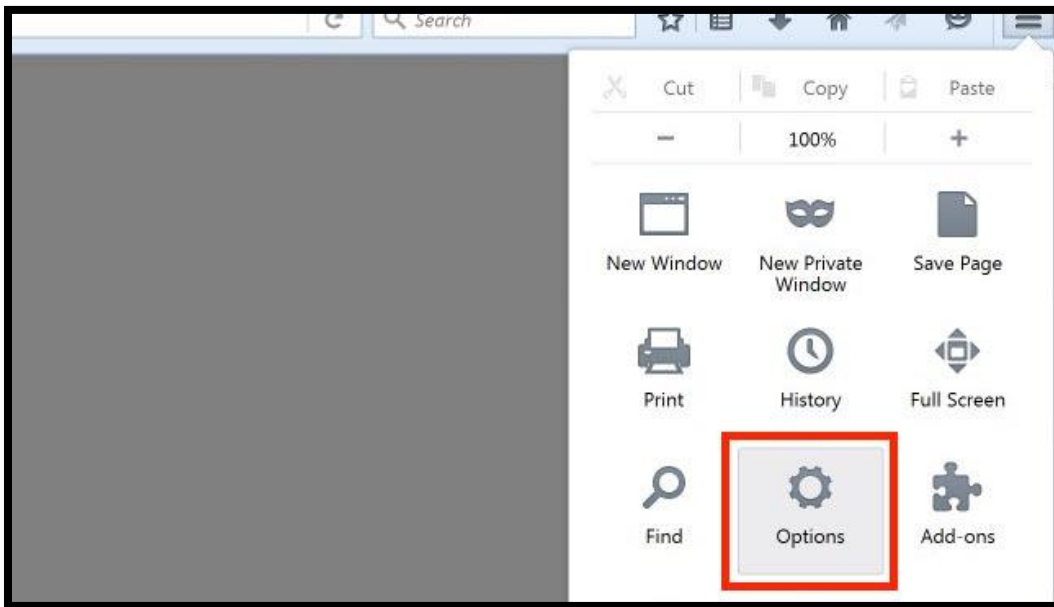


## Disable a Pop-Up Blocker Within Firefox Settings

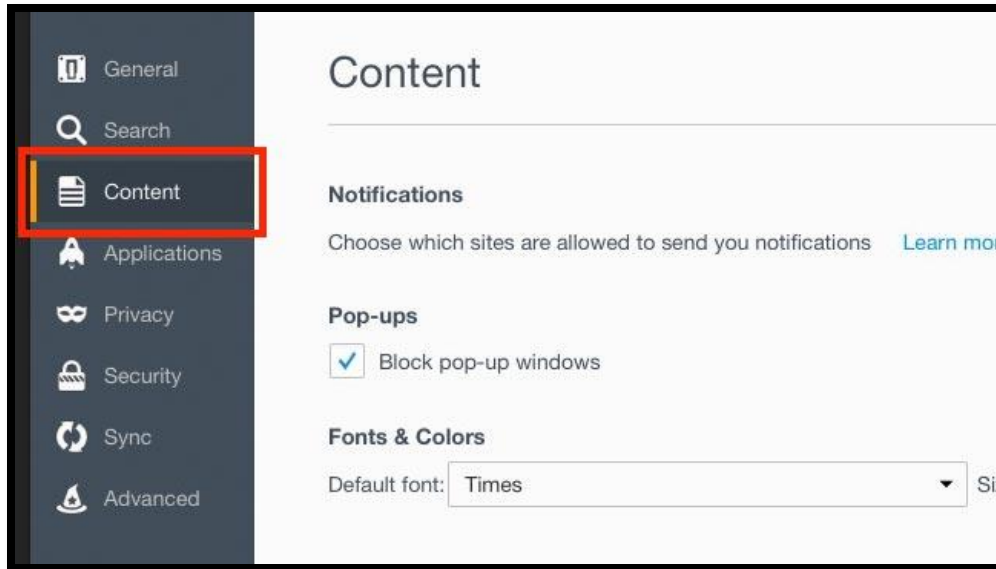
1. Open Firefox.
2. Click the Firefox menu in the upper right.



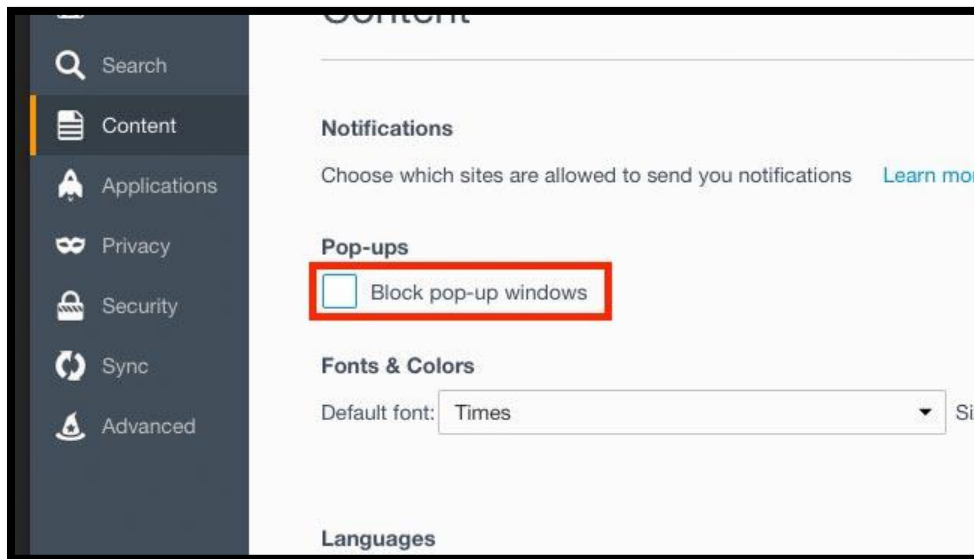
- 3. Click **Options** in the drop-down menu.

- 5. Under **Pop-ups** uncheck **Block pop-up windows**.



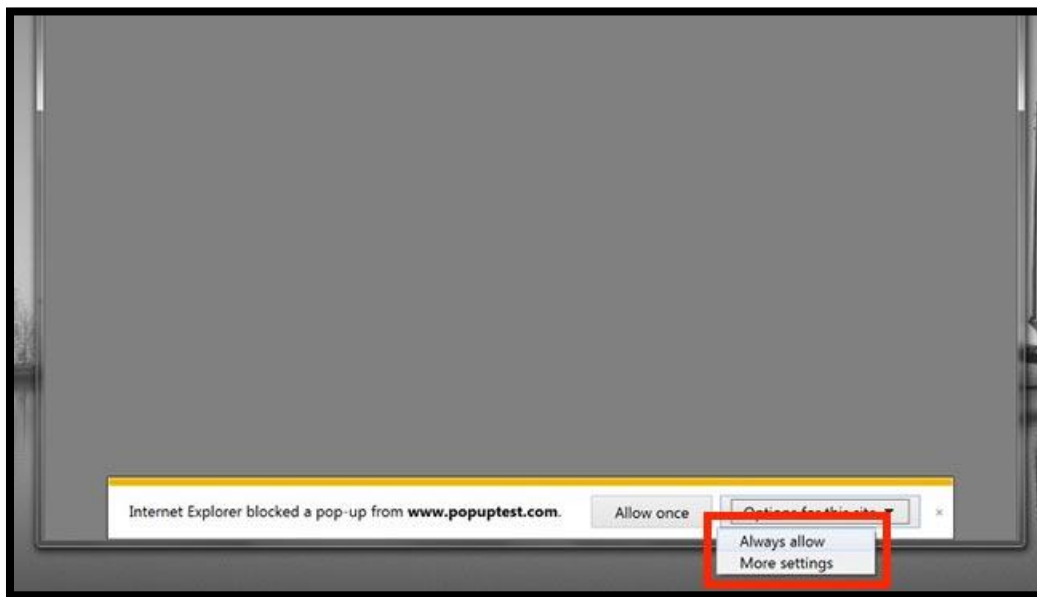
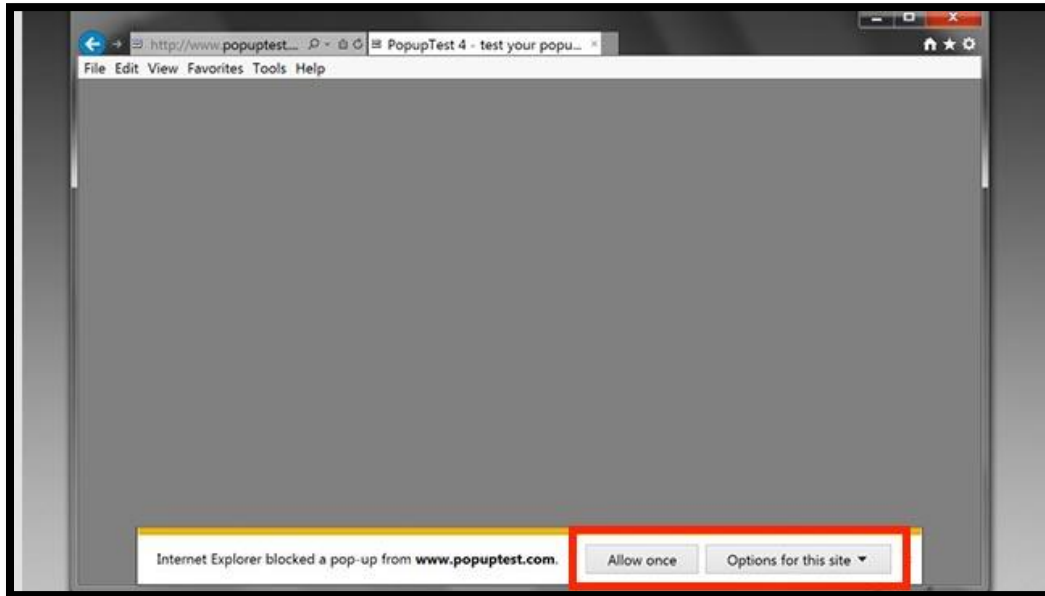
## How to Disable a Pop-Up Blocker Within Internet Explorer

### Disable a Pop-Up Blocker on a Web Page

If a Web page tries to send you a pop-up when your blocker is turned on, an information bar will appear at the top of your browser window.

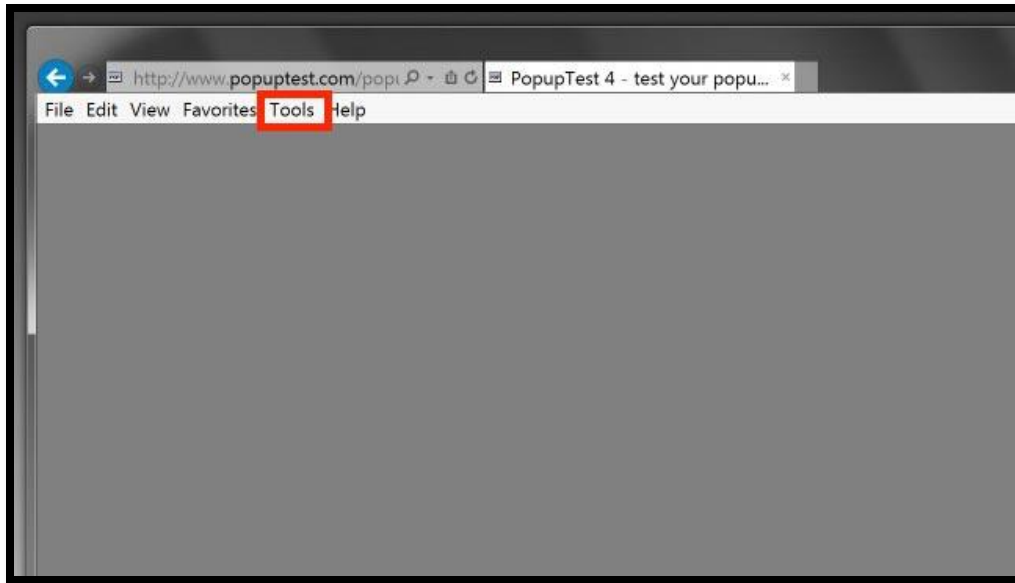
Clicking the information bar will allow you to:

- Temporarily allow pop-ups from this site (until you close your browser)
- Always allow pop-ups from this site
- Adjust your pop-up blocker settings

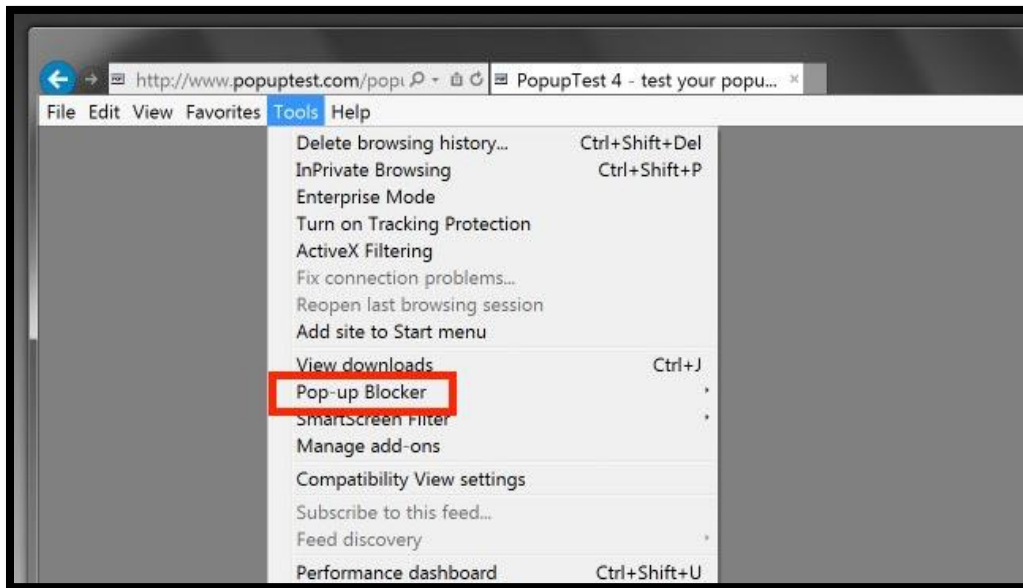


## Disable a Pop-Up Blocker Within Internet Explorer Settings

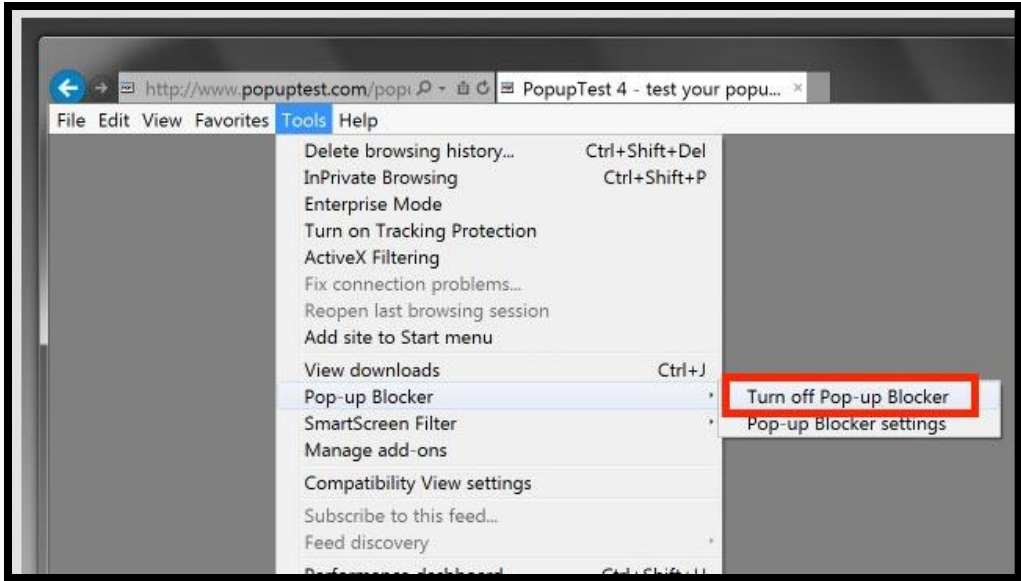
1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click **Tools** on the main menu.



- 3. Click **Pop-up Blocker** within the drop-down menu.

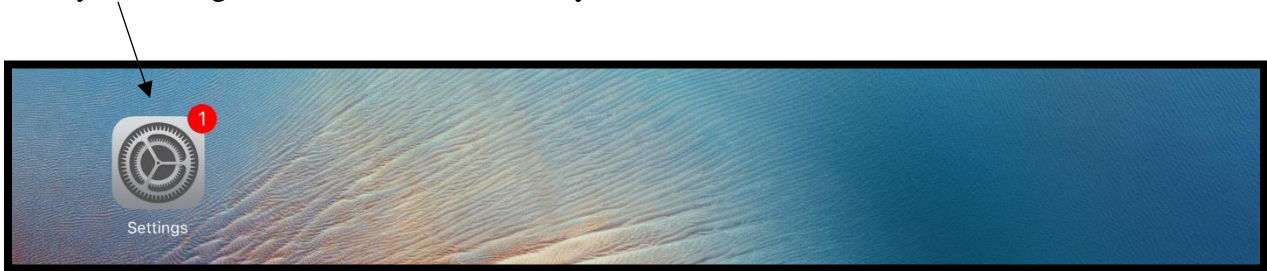


- 4. Click **Turn Off Pop-Up Blocker**.



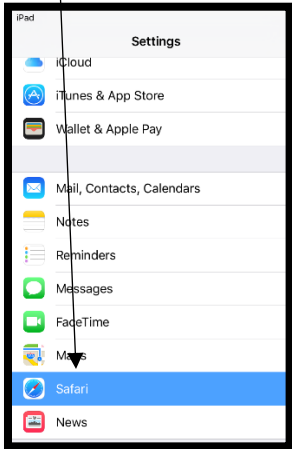
### Disable Pop Up Blocker on iPad or iPhone using Safari

Go to your settings from the home screen on your iPhone or iPad



Scroll down until you see Safari

Click on Safari



Make sure the Block Pop-ups is not selected. This means the button should be gray (or not green)
