10 FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES - DONALD W. REYNOLDS CENTER ON  
11 AGING, FAY W. BOOZMAN COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH,  
12 ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE, AND THE AREA HEALTH  
13 EDUCATION CENTER IN HELENA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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27 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - REYNOLDS CENTER ON AGING, BOOZMAN COLLEGE  
28 OF PUBLIC HEALTH, BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE, AND THE AREA HEALTH ED. CENTER -  
29 HELENA. There is hereby established for the University of Arkansas for  
30 Medical Sciences - Reynolds Center on Aging, Boozman College of Public  
31 Health, Biosciences Institute, and Area Health Education Center - Helena for  
32 the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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8 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - AREA HEALTH EDUCATION CENTER IN HELENA.

9 There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas for Medical  
 10 Sciences, to be payable from the Targeted State Needs Program Account of the  
 11 Tobacco Settlement Program Fund, for personal services and operating expenses  
 12 of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences - Area Health Education  
 13 Center in Helena for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the following:

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27 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS  
 29 CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL RESEARCH PROGRAM. In any fiscal year, if the funds  
 30 received by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the Arkansas  
 31 Biosciences Institute in the Arkansas Biosciences Institute appropriation in  
 32 this Act are less than the total amount appropriated, the University of  
 33 Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall provide no less than thirty-three and  
 34 one-third percent (33 and 1/3%) of the available funds for the Arkansas  
 35 Children's Hospital Research Program. Otherwise, the Arkansas Children's  
 36 Hospital Research Program line item appropriation in the Arkansas Biosciences

1 Institute appropriation in this Act shall be funded in total or Arkansas  
2 Children's Hospital Chief Executive Officer may request that the University  
3 of Arkansas for Medical Sciences transfer such funds each fiscal year from  
4 the Arkansas Biosciences Institute Program Account to the Department of Human  
5 Services Grants Fund Account. The transferred funds shall be used to match  
6 federal funds used for Supplemental Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's  
7 Hospital.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~  
9 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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11 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
13 RESTRICTIONS. The appropriations provided in this act shall not be  
14 transferred under the provisions of Arkansas Code 19-4-522, but only as  
15 provided by this act.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~  
17 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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19 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
21 PROVISIONS. The state-supported institution of higher education in this act  
22 may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each  
23 appropriation contained in this appropriation act. Such transfers shall be  
24 made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the  
25 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the approval of the Legislative  
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee.

27 The General Assembly has determined that the institution in this act could  
28 be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution  
29 and that flexibility is being accomplished by providing authority to transfer  
30 between items of appropriation made by this act. Since the General Assembly  
31 has granted the institution broad powers under the transfer of  
32 appropriations, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General  
33 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the transfers by requiring  
34 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee in the  
35 utilization of the transfer authority. Therefore, the requirement of  
36 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a

1 severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the  
2 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a  
3 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~  
5 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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7 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
9 POSITIONS. (a) Nothing in this act shall be construed as a commitment of the  
10 State of Arkansas or any of its agencies or institutions to continue funding  
11 any position paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement in the event  
12 that Tobacco Settlement funds are not sufficient to finance the position.

13 (b) State funds will not be used to replace Tobacco Settlement funds when  
14 such funds expire, unless appropriated by the General Assembly and authorized  
15 by the Governor.

16 (c) A disclosure of the language contained in (a) and (b) of this Section  
17 shall be made available to all new hire and current positions paid from the  
18 proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement by the Tobacco Settlement Commission.

19 (d) Whenever applicable the information contained in (a) and (b) of this  
20 Section shall be included in the employee handbook and/or Professional  
21 Services Contract paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~  
23 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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25 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

27 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act  
28 shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
29 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions  
30 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures  
31 Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,  
32 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and  
33 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as  
34 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said  
35 funds.

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1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
 3 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds  
 4 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act  
 5 shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was  
 6 adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 2000, the Agency Requests,  
 7 Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the  
 8 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
 9 letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas  
 10 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and  
 11 adoption.

12  
 13 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 14 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
 15 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of  
 17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 18 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm  
 20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 23 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
